A local law to provide for the retention of elected assessors in the Town of Lyme

Be it enacted by the Town of Lyme of the

A LOCAL LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE RETENTION OF ELECTED ASSESSORS IN THE TOWN OF LYME.

Be it enacted by the town board of the town of Lyme as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of section fifteen hundred and fifty-six of the real property tax law, the three offices of assessor of the town of Lyme, shall continue and shall be elective as provided by the law in effect immediately prior to the effective date of said section fifteen hundred and fifty-six.

Section 2. This local law shall be submitted for the approval of the electors of the town of Lyme at a special election to be held in accordance with the provisions of the municipal home rule law, except that such special election shall be held not later than 30 days after the date of the filing of this local law.

Section 3. This local law shall become effective on the twentieth day after approval thereof by the electors of the town of Lyme at the special election specified in section two hereof and after filing and publication as required by said municipal home rule law.
