Be it Enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Lyme  
Jefferson County as follows:

Section 1. The annual salary of the Justices of the  
Town of Lyme be and the same hereby is fixed at the sum  
of Two Thousand, Four Hundred Dollars (\$2,400) each  
until the end of his present term of office.

Section 2. This Local Law shall take effect immediately  
upon its approval by the electors or upon the expiration  
of the time for filing a petition requiring a referendum;  
if no petition is filed; and upon the filing of three  
certified copies here of in the office of the Secretary  
of State.
