Local Law No. 2 of the year 2003

A local law to add a Town administrative fee of \$2.50 per license to all dog licensing fees

Article 1. – Statement of Authority. The Town Board of the Town of Lyme, pursuant to the authority granted it under Section 110 (4) of the Agriculture and Markets Law and Sections 10 and 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, hereby enacts as follows:

Article 2. – Statement of Purpose and Findings. The Town Board of the Town of Lyme finds that it is incurring administrative expenses for processing dog licenses within the township. It is the purpose of this local law to try to make dog licensing costs neutral to the Town by collecting an additional fee to cover such processing expenses incurred by the Town.

Article 3. – Enactment. The Town Board of the Town of Lyme hereby enacts as follows: The Town Board shall hereby add to all other dog licensing fees otherwise required the sum of two dollars and fifty cents as its' administrative fee for issuing the licenses. Such additional fees shall be the property of the Town.

Article 4. – Severability. If any part of this local law shall be found to be void, voidable, or unenforceable for any reason whatsoever, it shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any remaining section or provision of this local law.

Article 5. – Effective Date. This local law shall become effective April 1, 2004 upon filing with the New York State Department of State.

NOTIFICATION OF COMMISSIONER - LOCAL LICENSE FEE

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. NYCRR Part 78 - Section 78.3 provides as follows:

Section 78.3 Notification of commissioner - local license fee

(a) Any city, town or licensing village may, by local law or ordinance, set local license fees as provided for by Article 7 of the Agriculture and Markets Law. Upon the filing of a written request by a municipality, the Department shall print the amount of said local license fee on the license renewal forms mailed to the dog owners in that municipality. The local license fee shall be printed on the license renewal forms within sixty days of the receipt of said request, or on the effective day of the local law or ordinance, whichever is longer. If the department does not receive a written request from a municipality, the license renewal forms sent to dog owners in that municipality will not bear a local license fee and it shall be the responsibility of the municipality to notify dog owners of local fees.

2. Attach copy of law or ordinance initializing the local fee.

3. This form must also be completed and submitted to this Department anytime there is a change in the status of the local fee in your municipality, along with a copy of the local law or ordinance.
