Article 1. - Authority. The Town Board of the Town of Lyme, pursuant to the authority granted it under Articles 12 and 12a of the Town Law and Sections 10 and 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, hereby enacts as follows:

Article 2. - Statement of Purpose and Finding. The Town Board of the Town of Lyme has determined that it is necessary to review water rates in order to generate sufficient revenues to cover all budgetary expenses. It is the purpose of this local law to amend such rates.

Article 3. - Enactment. The Town Board of the Town of Lyme hereby enacts the water rates follows:
