Section 1. On and after the effective date of this Local Law, the Village of Chaumont shall cease to be an assessing unit and Village taxes shall hereafter be levied on a copy of the Town assessment roll.

Section 2. The positions of Assessor and the Board of Assessment Review in the Village of Chaumont are hereby abolished.

Section 3. This Local Law shall take effect thirty (30) days after adoption, or upon approval of the affirmative vote of the qualified electors of the Village voting on a proposition for its approval if within thirty (30) days after adoption there be filed a petition with the Village Clerk, pursuant to Section 9-902 of the Village Law, and upon filing of certified copies hereof in the office of the Secretary of State.

*Elective Chief Executive Officer means or includes the chief executive officer of a county elected on a county-wide basis or, if there be none, the chairman of the county legislative body, the mayor of a city or village or the supervisor of a town, where such officer is vested with power to approve or veto local laws or ordinances.

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. of 19..... of the City of..... having been submitted to referendum pursuant to the provisions of § 36 § 37 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of such city voting thereon at the special general election held on 19 became operative.


