Section 1. Legislative Authority

The Village Board of the Village of Chaumont, pursuant to the authority granted to it by Article 17 of the General Municipal Law; the Municipal Home Rule Law; and the Resolution, Findings and Order adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Lyme and Village Board of the Village of Chaumont hereby enacts as follows:

Section 2. Statement of Purpose

The following described territory situated in the Town of Lyme shall be annexed into the Village of Chaumont:

Lands owned by James L. Bevens located at 11856 Co. Rte. 125 in the Town of Lyme, New York.
The subject property is also known as tax parcel number 61.15-1-2.

Section 3. Effective Date

The Local Law shall take effect upon filing with the Office of the Department of State as required by the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law and the General Municipal Law.
