A LOCAL LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE RETWINION OF PLEGTED ASSESSORS IN THE TOWN OF LINE.

Do it enacted by the town board of the town of Igme as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of saction fifteen hundred and fifty-six of the real property tax low, the three offices of ascessor of the tean of Lyme, shall continue and shall be elective as provided by the low in extent immediately prior to the effective date of said section fifteen bundred and fifty-six.

Section2. This local law shall be submitted for the approvalof the electors of the town of Lyme at a special election to be hald in a condense with the provisions of the sumicipal home rule law, except that such special election

Section 3. This local law shall become effective on the twentieth day after approval thereof by the electors of the town of Lyme at the special election specified in section two hereof and ofter filling and publication as required by said municipal home rule law.
