- §1. <u>Title</u>. This Local Law shall be known and cited as THE GAMES OF CHANCE LAW of the Town of Lyme.
- §2. <u>Definitions</u>. As used in this Local Law all words shall have the same meanings as those defined in Section 186 of the New York General Municipal Law and Title 9 of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations Section 5600.1.
- §3. Games of Chance Authorized. Authorized organizations may, upon obtaining a license from the Town Clerk, conduct Games of Chance within the Town of Lyme as provided in Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law, the Rules and Regulations of the New York State Racing and Wagering Board, and as provided further in this Local Law.
- §4. Restrictions. The conduct of Games of Chance shall be subject to the restrictions imposed by Section 189 of the General Municipal Law and the Rules and Regulations of the New York State Racing and Wagering Board.
- §5. <u>Sunday Games</u>. Games of Chance may be conducted on Sundays between the hours of Noon and Midnight only, unless the following day is a legal holiday. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this section, no Games of Chance shall be conducted on Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or New Year's Eve Day.
- §6. <u>Enforcement</u>. The Chief of Police of the Town of Lyme shall exercise control and supervision over all Games of Chance conducted under a duly authorized license. The Chief of Police shall have all the powers and duties set forth in Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law.

§7. Effective Date.
